2023 has brought lots of exciting projects for Rail74 CRP and their partners along our line.

- Another year of record amounts of funding for projects within Lanarkshire
- Building relationships with our train operator supporters
- Projects celebrated and helped completed this year :
 - Our successful travelling classrooms/inclusivity matters project have shown directly over 80 children and adults a view and understanding of our autistic friends. Helping our communities and train operating staff understand the challenges people may face therefore bringing greater kindness & empathy.
 - Celebrating at award ceremonies for Scotrail and VASLAN for our entries supporting the community and promoting Scotland's Railways.
 - Reaching over 400 people along our line through Conversation Café on the trains supporting mental heath awareness/Samaritans'
 - For the 1st Time in Scotland 2 CRPS worked together Rail 74 CRP and 6VT CRP collaboratively produced an intergenerational United in Learning project with a twovisit experience & teaching each other new skills and breaking down perception barriers of railways & age groups.
 - Winning a Scotrail CRP member of the year award for Suzie's work in project delivery.
 - Creating a partnership with local school and nursery around Newton station.
 - Showing support and advising on Active green travel with the monthly greening Camglen network of like-minded climate activists
 - Community rail week/rail safety involvement
 - Creating our very own Tiktok channel to showcase the work we do
 - Sharing the love and learning with other CRPs around Scotland and the UK

Into 2024 - Sounds like a volunteer which came from community needs to increase volunteers in greenspaces along our line using QR codes and podcasts to celebrate and encourage new people to join community rail and wider groups, an accessible day out guide in south/north Lanarkshire to support all disabilities using the train.
